MINUTES

• 08.28.2023 minutes approved with corrections.

Story - Article 10 (Compensation)

- SPALC recommended 8% increase across the board.
- The FEA Bargaining Specialist shared a compensation presentation.
- The State requires 3% in fund. 3% won't allow the district to do things like pay employees during COVID or hurricane.

FY24 (school year 2023-2024) SPALC Bargaining Session – September 11, 2023 Page 1 of 4 pages



- Generally, districts hold more than 3%.
- \$2.7 million was the initial option. This was never intended for it to be the end option.
- The district's current bargaining authority is \$2.7 million. SPALC is requesting another \$5.7 million.
- The district can come back after the salary schedule report.
- The district is interested in taking bookkeepers to market rate. The district will
 meet with the board to share SPALC's request for an additional \$5.7 million
 which is ≈ 8.4 million total.

CAUCUS

<u>District Report Out</u>: Discussed the \$2.7 million and the Bargaining Specialist presentation.

Options

- 1. \$2.7 million
- 2. Additional \$5.7 million (≈ \$8.4 million)
- 3. Commitment to come back to the bargaining table in March 2024.
- 4. 2% and hygiene supplement for Instructional Support floaters for \$500.
- 5. 2% and bookkeepers to market rate.
- 6. Continuous years of service;
 - \circ Years 1-10 = 2% increase
 - Years 11+ = 4% increase
- 7. \$50/day for SPALC Employees who cover classes.
- 8. 3% for safety specialist and attendants, clinic assistants, LPN, head custodians, FNS assistant managers, interpreters DHH, remainder unit is 2%.

CAUCUS

- <u>SPALC Report Out</u>: Cannot go any further until see the district goes back for more bargaining authority.
- <u>District Report Out</u>: Clarity about options, the options all include dividing up the \$2.7 million.
