This agenda item is specifically for a one-time approval to increase the previously Board approved amount of \$450,000.00 by \$1,852,843.00, for a total up to \$2,302,843.00. Funds will only be expended within the existing resources of the applicable locations.
Recommended Action	<p>Approval to increase the previously Board approved amount of \$450,000.00 by \$1,852,843.00, for a total up to \$2,302,843.00, with AMSWFL, Inc. d/b/a Architectural Metals of SW Florida, Inc. and Benchmark Metals, Inc. of Cape Coral, FL, for the period of October 3, 2023 through May 1, 2024, pursuant to the same terms and conditions as previously approved by the Board. The \$1,852,843.00 increase is requested due to additional anticipated projects. Goals	 Objective 5 - Increase Operational Efficiency and Effectiveness

Invitation To Negotiate No. N237442DB is for Aluminum Walkways, Covers and Canvas. Services and products include materials and services necessary for repairs, maintenance, installation and/or extensions of permanent walkway covers or canvas covered walkway covers. This ITN also allows for installation of walkway covered structures that create safe locations for student/parent pick-ups and drop-offs. The \$1,852,843.00 increase is requested due to additional anticipated projects. The anticipated projects include, but are not limited to:

- o \$650,000.00 – Covered Structures (Capital)
(Harns Marsh Elementary School, Pelican Elementary School, Skyline Elementary School, Tropic Isles Elementary School, Varsity Lakes Middle School)
- o \$250,000.00 – Trafalgar Middle School (Walkway Cover)
- o \$200,000.00 – North Fort Myers High School (Parent Pickup)
- o \$200,000.00 – Pelican Elementary School (Walkway, new or replacement)
- o \$189,950.00 – Ray V. Pottorf Elementary School (Hurricane Ian)

- o \$150,000.00 – Anticipated canopies (Hurricane Ian)
- o \$140,000.00 – Day-to-day repairs (Maintenance)
- o \$58,608.00 – Lehigh Elementary School (Hurricane Ian)
- o \$14,285.00 – Orangewood Elementary School (Hurricane Ian)

On April 11, 2023 this ITN was awarded to AMSWFL, Inc. d/b/a Architectural Metals of SW Florida, Inc. and Benchmark Metals, Inc. of Cape Coral, FL, for the period of May 2, 2023 through May 1, 2026, with renewal options for three additional one-year periods. It is recommended the Board approve the increase to the previously Board approved expenditure amount of \$450,000.00, by \$1,852,843.00, for a total up to \$2,302,843.00, with AMSWFL, Inc. dba Architectural Metals of SW Florida, Inc. and Benchmark Metals, Inc., for the period of October 3, 2023 through May 1, 2024, pursuant to the same terms and conditions as previously approved by the Board.
