

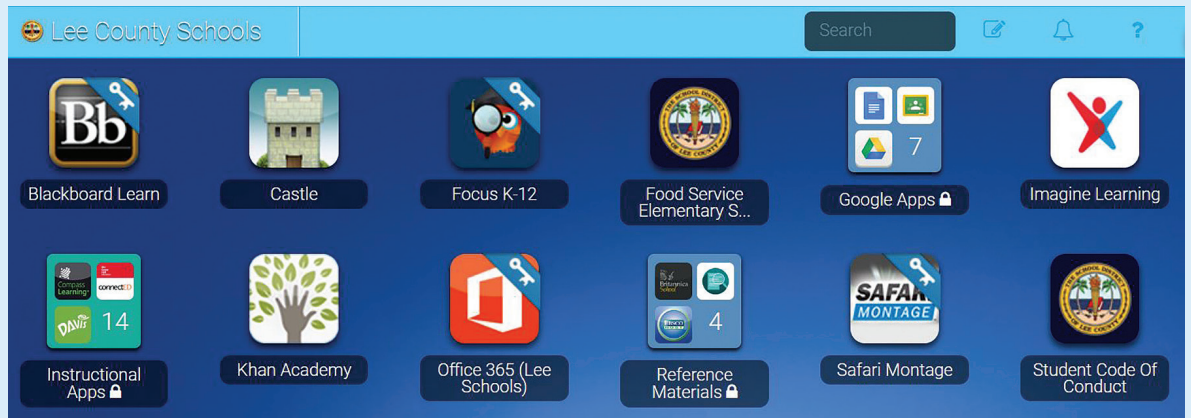

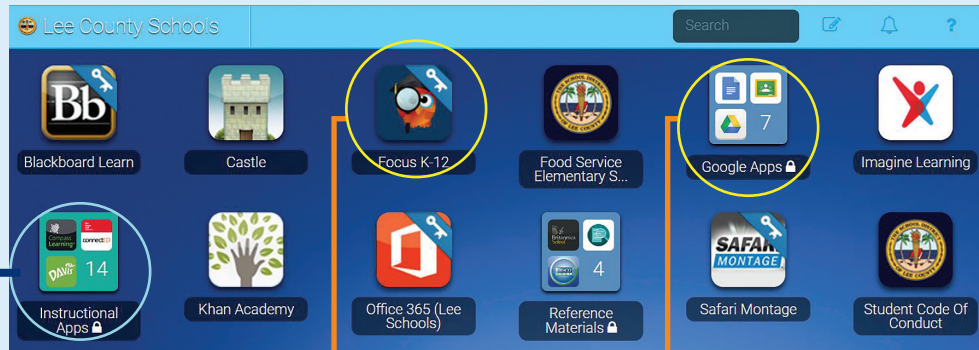

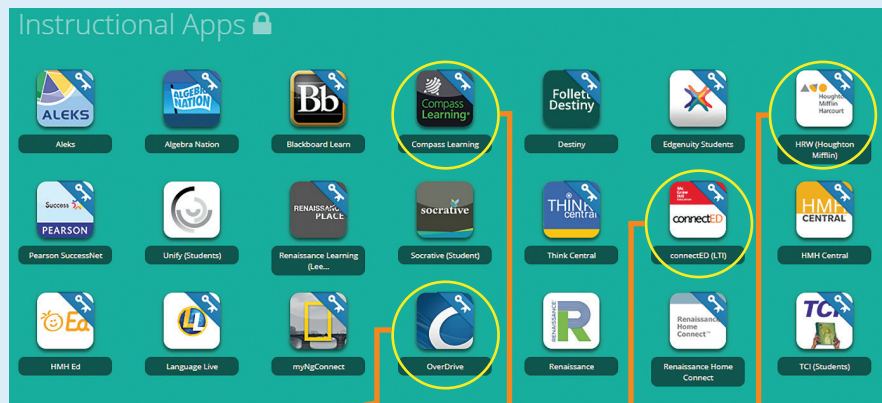


FOCUS K-12:
