Options

From Flagler County Schools' dress code:

- 1. A. Lee County Schools' objective in establishing a professional casual dress code is to allow our employees to work comfortably in their workplace as appropriate to perform their specific job responsibilities while projecting a professional image for our students, parents, colleagues, potential employers, and community
 - D. Jeans may be worn so long as the employee portrays an overall professional image. Bottoms may not have rips, holes, tears, or frayed edges
- 2. Keep part A, amend "Jeans" in part D to say "clothing may not have rips, tears, or frayed edges
- 3. No worksite shall implement a specific dress code for instructional employees unless approved by 60% of the instructional staff
