Approval to renew RFP No. R167266TA for Group Critical Illness and Group Accident Insurance, awarded to Allstate Benefits, for the second and final renewal period of April 1, 2024 through March 31, 2026, pursuant to the same terms and conditions as previously approved by the Board. The School Board of Lee County offers employees working twenty (20) or more hours per week, in a regular position, a menu of voluntary (employee paid) benefits. This voluntary insurance benefit helps employees take control of their health when faced with a critical illness or an unexpected accident. Approval authorizes the

Superintendent to execute all related documents.

Request for Proposal No. R167266TA is for Group Critical Illness and Group Accident Insurance. The School Board of Lee County offers employees working twenty (20) or more hours per week, in a regular position, a menu of voluntary (employee paid) benefits. This voluntary insurance benefit helps employees take control of their health when faced with a critical illness or an unexpected accident. On September 13, 2016, this RFP was awarded to Allstate Benefits, for a five-year period, beginning April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2022, and renewed through March 31, 2024, with one more two-year renewal option available. It is recommended the Board approve the renewal with Allstate Benefits for the second and final renewal period of April 1, 2024 through March 31, 2026, pursuant to the same terms and conditions as previously approved by the Board.
