Suwannee County School District RFP No. 20-209, for TYPE IIB Panelized Modular Buildings, was awarded to Mobile Modular Management Corporation in Auburndale, FL, for the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2025. This piggyback allows for the purchase, rental, and relocation of modular classrooms, multipurpose buildings, restroom buildings, office buildings, medical clinic buildings, storage units, stairs, ramps, and awnings. It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$750,000.00, for the period of July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
