Budget Source	Up to \$175,000.00 will be funded from budgeted School/Department funds. This agenda item is specifically for the approval of the piggyback. Funds will only be expended within the existing resources of the applicable locations.
Recommended Action	Approval to piggyback Orange County Public Schools ITB2201011, for Marching Band Uniforms, awarded to DeMoulin Brothers & Company, Fruhauf Uniforms, Inc., Ictus Limited, Inc., and Stanbury Uniforms, LLC for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024, for up to \$175,000.00, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District. This contract supports the purchase of marching band uniforms. Each year, two high schools receive funding for new marching band uniforms. This year, Dunbar High School and Bonita Springs High School will purchase their new uniforms. In addition, replacement accessories such as gloves, shakos and plume feathers can be purchased as needed for all schools. Approval authorizes the Superintendent to execute all related documents.

Orange County Public Schools ITB2201011, for Marching Band Uniforms, was awarded to DeMoulin Brothers & Company, Fruhauf Uniforms, Inc., Ictus Limited, Inc., and Stanbury Uniforms, LLC for the period of April 27, 2022 through April 26, 2025. This contract supports the purchase of marching band uniforms. Each year, two high schools receive funding for new marching band uniforms. This year, Dunbar High School and Bonita Springs High School will purchase their new uniforms. In addition, replacement accessories such as gloves, shakos and plume feathers can be purchased as needed for all schools. It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$175,000.00, for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
