The School Board of Lee County offers employees working twenty (20) or more hours per week, in a regular position, a menu of voluntary (employee paid) benefits. This voluntary insurance benefit helps protect employees finances from life's unpredictable events such as cancer and specific diseases. Approval authorizes the

Superintendent to execute all related documents.

Request for Proposals No. R177286CN is for Group Cancer and Specified Diseases Insurance. The School Board of Lee County offers employees working twenty (20) or more hours per week, in a regular position, a menu of voluntary (employee paid) benefits. This voluntary insurance benefit helps protect employees finances from life's unpredictable events such as cancer and specific diseases. On June 6, 2017, this RFP was awarded to Allstate Benefits, for a five-year period, beginning September 29, 2017 through March 31, 2022, and renewed through March 31, 2024, with one more renewal option available. It is recommended the Board approve the renewal with Allstate Benefits for the third and final renewal period of April 1, 2024 through March 31, 2025, pursuant to the same terms and conditions as previously approved by the Board.
