Goals Strategic Priority: Improving Internal Operating Systems

Orange County Public Schools ITB2201011, for Marching Band Uniforms, was awarded to DeMoulin Brothers and Company in Greenville, Illinois; Fruhauf Uniforms, Inc., in Wichita, Kansas; Ictus Limited, Inc., in Ocala, Florida; and Stanbury Uniforms, LLC in Brookfield, Missouri, for the period of April 27, 2022 through April 26, 2025. This contract supports the revolving refresh of District high school marching band uniforms. Each year, two high schools receive funding for new marching band uniforms. This year, Estero High School and Riverdale High School are in the rotation. In addition, replacement accessories such as gloves, shakos and plume feathers can be purchased as needed by all District schools.

It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$175,000.00, for the period of July 1, 2024 through April 26, 2025, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
