**ALTERNATE PRODUCTS**

If alternate products, other than those listed in the specifications, are required, the cost to the District of the alternate products shall be based on the Contractor's wholesale price from the supply house, and shall include a negotiated fixed fee. The District reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to furnish equipment and materials for any and all jobs or work performed pursuant to this contract. Invoices must include an aggregate cost for all alternate manufacturer products, including the wholesale price from the supply house, plus the correlated fixed fee identified (above) for the aggregate amount.

**COST OF MATERIALS**

The cost of materials shall be based on the Contractor's wholesale price from the supply house, plus the correlated fixed fee. Invoices must include an aggregate cost for all materials, including the sum of wholesale price from the supply house, plus the correlated fixed fee identified in Table 1: Fixed Fee Rate Schedule (above) for the aggregate amount. The District reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to furnish equipment and materials for any and all jobs or work performed pursuant to this contract.

**RENTAL EQUIPMENT**

The cost of rental equipment will be reimbursed at the correlated fixed fee identified in Table 1: Fixed Fee Rate Schedule (above). Invoices must include an aggregate cost for all rental equipment, including the cost from the supplier, plus the negotiated fixed rate. All credits for rentals are to be returned to the District.

**SUB-CONTRACTED LABOR RATES**

Sub-Contracted labor rates are to be billed at either a rate not to exceed the contractor labor rates, or at a fixed rate to be negotiated at the time of work.
