Approval to award ITN No. N237448AN for Voluntary Group Short-Term and Long-Term Disability Insurance, to Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, as indicated on the attached tabulation sheet. This ITN will be effective for three years, beginning April 1, 2024 through March 31, 2027, with renewal options for three additional one-year periods, upon the written agreement of the vendor and the District. The School Board of Lee County offers employees working twenty (20) or more hours per week, in a regular position, a menu of voluntary (employee paid) benefits including Short-Term Disability and Long-Term Disability Insurance. Services include a benefit paid weekly, for short-term disability or monthly, for long term disability, for qualifying disabilities. The Insurance Task Force (ITF) subcommittee, comprised of ITF members, including representatives from Insurance and Benefits Management and the Florida Education Association, reviewed the scoring committee recommendation in their September 7, 2023 meeting. Approval

authorizes the Superintendent to execute all related documents.

The Insurance Task Force (ITF) subcommittee, comprised of ITF members, including representatives from Insurance and Benefits Management and the Florida Education Association, reviewed the scoring committee recommendation in their September 7, 2023 meeting.
