Approval to piggyback E&I Cooperative Services Contract No. CNR01399, for Fleet Leasing Services, awarded to Enterprise Fleet Management in St. Louis, MO with many locations throughout Lee County, for the period of May 24, 2024 through May 23, 2025, for up to \$125,000.00, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District. Approval authorizes the Superintendent to execute all

related documents.

E&I Cooperative Services Contract No. CNR01399, for Fleet Leasing Services, was awarded to Enterprise Fleet Management in St. Louis, MO with many locations throughout Lee County, for the period of April 1, 2016 through December 31, 2021, and renewed through December 31, 2026. This contract supports the Florida Summer BreakSpot Program. This program allows the Food and Nutrition Services Department to provide free meals to children who are 18 years and younger at no cost to them during the summer. This summer, breakfast, and lunch will be served at more than 80 school-based and community sites in Lee County between June 5, 2024 and July 31, 2024. There are no income requirements or registration. Anyone age 18 or younger may come to eat. The rental of these vehicles will be used for transporting meals for students during the summertime. It is recommended the Board approve this piggyback, for up to \$125,000.00, for the period of May 24, 2024 through May 23, 2025, with an option to cancel if deemed to be in the best interest of the District.
