New Accelerated Pathways Students

- Have an updated Spring 2021 application.
- Take/ submit college placement scores from ACT, SAT, Accuplacer or PERT
- FSW Accelerated Pathways Orientation at www.fsw.edu/dualenrollment.

Returning DE/EA- Missing Scores

- Testing is determined on current DE/EA courses
- Course progression is determined by success in your DE/EA courses.



Missing Test Score- Reading

- If you are taking any DE/EA courses currently, you will receive a Reading Exemption score.
- You will be eligible to take up to 12 credits total in Reading required courses (ex, SLS, AMH, POS, PSY, PHI).



Missing Test Score- Writing

- If you are currently taking ENC 1101 or ENC 1102, you will receive a Writing Exemption score.
- You will be eligible to take up to 12 credits total in courses that require Reading and Writing scores.



Missing Test Score- Math

- If you are currently taking a Math course (MAT 1033, MAC 1105, etc), you will receive a Math Exemption score.
- You will be eligible to take up to 12 credits total in courses that require Reading and Math scores.



Scores or Alternative Assessments

- If a student has all eligible test scores or is coming in with a full set of alternative assessments (or a combination of both), they can continue taking full advantage of FSW's courses, up to 18 credits without additional testing.
- However, if a student does not earn a "C" or higher in the prerequisite course or falls below a 2.0 term GPA, the student will be removed from Spring courses they have not met the minimum requirement for.



Next Steps

- If you are wanting to take more than 12 credits TOTAL for Fall and Spring, and do not meet the test score or alternative coursework listed above, you will need to sign up for testing.
- Go to www.fsw.edu/testing, under Placement Testing Registration, choose which option is best for you.
- The FSW Testing team will work with you to determine which subject test(s) you will need to take.
- DE students will be automatically given the Accuplacer test, unless the PERT is specifically requested.
- If you have other scores, such as SAT or ACT, see your school counselor to submit those scores prior to testing and registration.
- If students have not met the required scores, there is an appeals process through the Director Accelerated Pathways. You will need to speak with your counselor before approval as there are some documents that will be needed.
- DE registration is from October 29th-December 1st for all FSW on-campus and online courses.
